teamLab Borderless in Tokyo Featured in TIME's Annual List of the World's Greatest Places of 2024



teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM (teamLab Borderless) has been announced as one of TIME's World's Greatest Places of 2024. TIME's annual list of the World's Greatest Places, a project that began in 2018, highlights 100 extraordinary destinations to visit and stay.

To compile this list, TIME solicited nominations of places—including hotels, cruises, restaurants, attractions, museums, parks, and more—from its international network of correspondents and contributors, with an eye toward those offering new and exciting experiences.

TIME said, "teamLab Borderless puts an atmospheric twist on a genre that's become a social media cliche...In the breathtaking installation *Universe of Water*

Particles on a Rock where People Gather a simulated waterfall cascades down the walls and across the floor, calibrating its flow and intensity based on how people movethrough the gallery. In the ephemeral Bubble Universe/Microcosmoses flickering spheres of light hung at varying heights react to the humans nearest them, creating a hypnotic ripple effect that can never be replicated".
