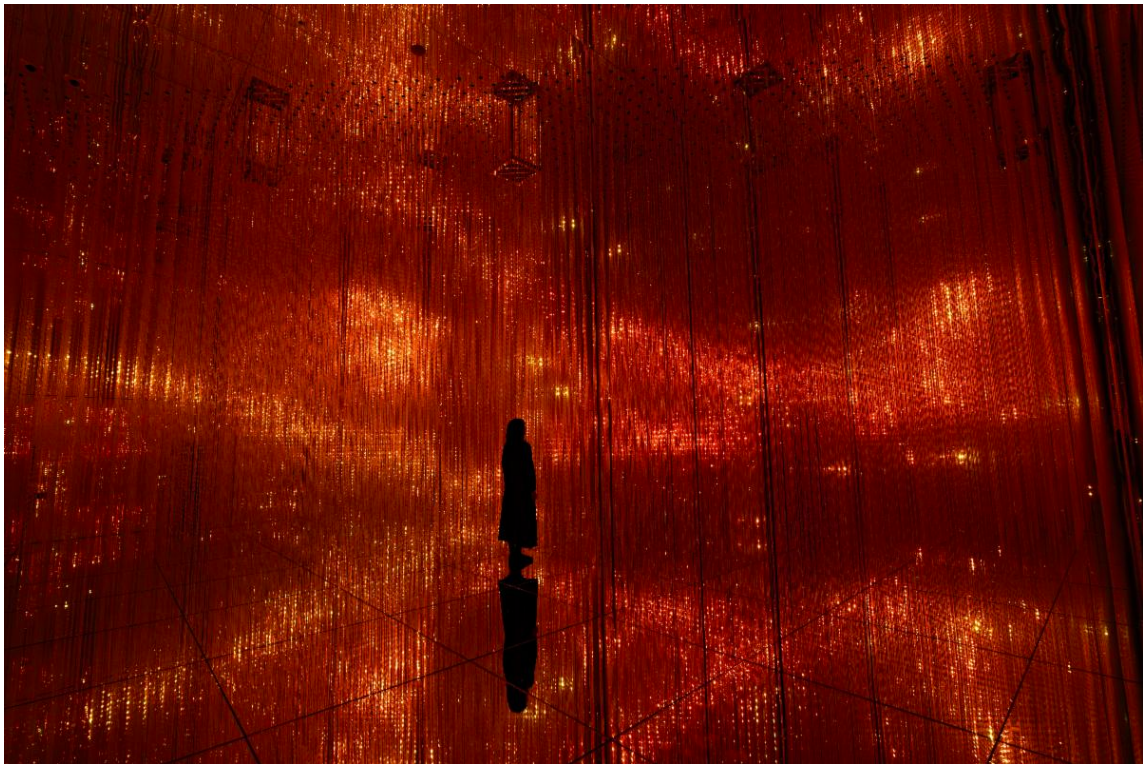

teamLab Unveils Newly Added Artwork at teamLab Borderless in Tokyo

On May 20, 2026, teamLab unveiled the newly added artwork Crows are Chased and the Chasing Crows are Destined to be Chased as well: Crystal World at teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM at Azabudai Hills, Tokyo.

This work starts when the crows from Crows are Chased and the Chasing Crows are Destined to be Chased as well: Flying Beyond Borders enter the Infinite Crystal World space, where points of light are used to create three-dimensional light sculptures extending infinitely in all directions. The crows fly around freely, beyond the boundaries of other works, influencing each other. The work ends when the crows leave the space.

Flocks of mythical crows (Yatagarasu) drawn in points of light fly around the space, leaving trails in their wake and forming Spatial Calligraphy. The chasing crows are eventually chased themselves and form flowers when they crash into each other, scattering their petals.

WITHERS TAIZAN BONSAI reinterprets the Japanese tradition of bonsai as contemporary art, using trees that would otherwise be discarded after withering. Each work is reconstructed with a modern sensibility, preserving the time etched into the trunk and the sculptural beauty shaped by nature. Made entirely from real plant materials and preserved through a unique technique, the artworks require no watering or maintenance and can be enjoyed indoors for many years.

The Executive Museum Lounge Atrium on the 25th floor of Park Hotel Tokyo offers sweeping views of Tokyo from above. Within this serene space, reborn bonsai art stands quietly, adding a subtle yet lasting artistic presence to your time in the city. From Park Hotel Tokyo's perspective—where art itself becomes hospitality—this exhibition presents a dialogue between Japanese culture, sustainability, and contemporary art. Each reborn bonsai art piece is entirely one of a kind—no two are ever the same. They invite you to look beyond the form and reflect on the time and story embodied within each piece.
